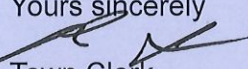

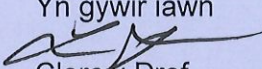

88 ASSOCIATION UPDATE

Cllr G. Sandilands asked for any Association Updates from the Councillors, no Councillors had any updates to provide. Will be an agenda item for next meeting on 11.10.23 CCTV, Tourism, PBF, etc.

89 COMMUNITY ASSET TRANSFER BUSINESS PLAN: TY PENDRE

Cllr C. Evans queried when the radio group will use Ty Pendre. The Town Clerk had been informed usage would be during the day and evenings.

Cllr C. Evans expressed her concerns for the condition of the walls within Ty Pendre, Mayor Cllr B. Murray agreed stating they will require DBC.

Cllr G. Sandilands expressed his shock to how much work is required at Ty Pendre. The Town Clerk said the work will be quote via a tender process.

90 EVENTS UPDATE JULY 2023

The Town Clerk informed all Councillors that Prestatyn Town Council have been successful in receiving half the grant applied for the dementia events £2,491. Requesting the balance of costs £2,491 to be met by the council.

ALL (4) AGREED UNANIMOUSLY

The Town Clerk reported on the success of the Play Bus's first day having over 60 children during the morning.

Cllr K. Clewett asked if Warm Hubs Initiative will return this Winter, and whether a similar Initiative will take place during the Summer. The Town Clerk replied, yet no plans have been confirmed to bring the Warm Hub Initiative back during Winter 2023. Also, unaware of any grants available now.

The Town Clerk explained that a grant had been received in partnership with NEWCIS for well-being sessions which start in August.

Denbighshire County Council are holding drop-in sessions in the chambers along with SP Energy offering advice for consumers.

The Town Clerk has invited Denbighshire County Council to showcase their services in an event during Autumn.

The Town Clerk also spoke about the possibility of Teen's nutritional/cooking and financial/cost of living sessions to be held in the chambers over the summer.

Members all commented on the success of the Carnival and 'Thanked' Joy and the committee for all their hard work on organising a brilliant event.

Town Clerk has already written a 'thank you' on behalf of the town council.

Mayor Cllr B. Murray informed Councillors that during the Prestatyn Carnival pre-meeting, himself and consort Cllr C. Holliday met a mechanical Welsh Dragon Mascot and the owner offered to attend various Prestatyn Town Council events throughout the year free of charge. The Town Clerk would contact the company.

Cllr C. Evans commented on the great variety of events.

91 SOCIAL MEDIA UPDATE JULY 2023

Cllr G. Sandilands raised his concerns in which feels Prestatyn and Meliden's Town Council's Social Media platforms advertise too many events happening outside of Prestatyn and Meliden.

The Town Clerk explained that outside events are only advertised if relevant and nothing similar happening in Prestatyn, or supporting a partnership organisation, or to promote charity events.

Cllr G. Sandilands queried old Social Media accounts under the Town Council that are still present, and wondered if they could be removed.

The Town Clerk explained that all Social Media accounts and processes are currently being reviewed and that realistic targets are being set each month to increase reach/activity.

Mayor Cllr B. Murray expressed how well advertising is becoming for Prestatyn and Meliden, as a substantial amount of people from surrounding areas are coming to visit Prestatyn and Meliden regularly. He also spoke about the large amount of positive feedback the Towns have received from visitors and residents within Prestatyn and Meliden, voicing how bright and alluring they are.

PROPOSAL

Every year Prestatyn Town Council are charged £12,700 by Denbighshire County Council for Car Park charging. I have been informed this is a long-standing arrangement covering some costs relating to FREE 4-hour parking.

A meeting with Mike Jones has been requested for over a year now to explain to the Town Clerk/Members what Denbighshire County Council charge covers. A date is still not been offered.

Every year Prestatyn Town Council are asked to provide **5** dates for the residents, visitors, community, etc; to use the car parks for **FREE** during the hours of 8am - 5pm.

The following car parks are included in the scheme for **FREE** use on the agreed dates.

Kings Ave

Fern Ave

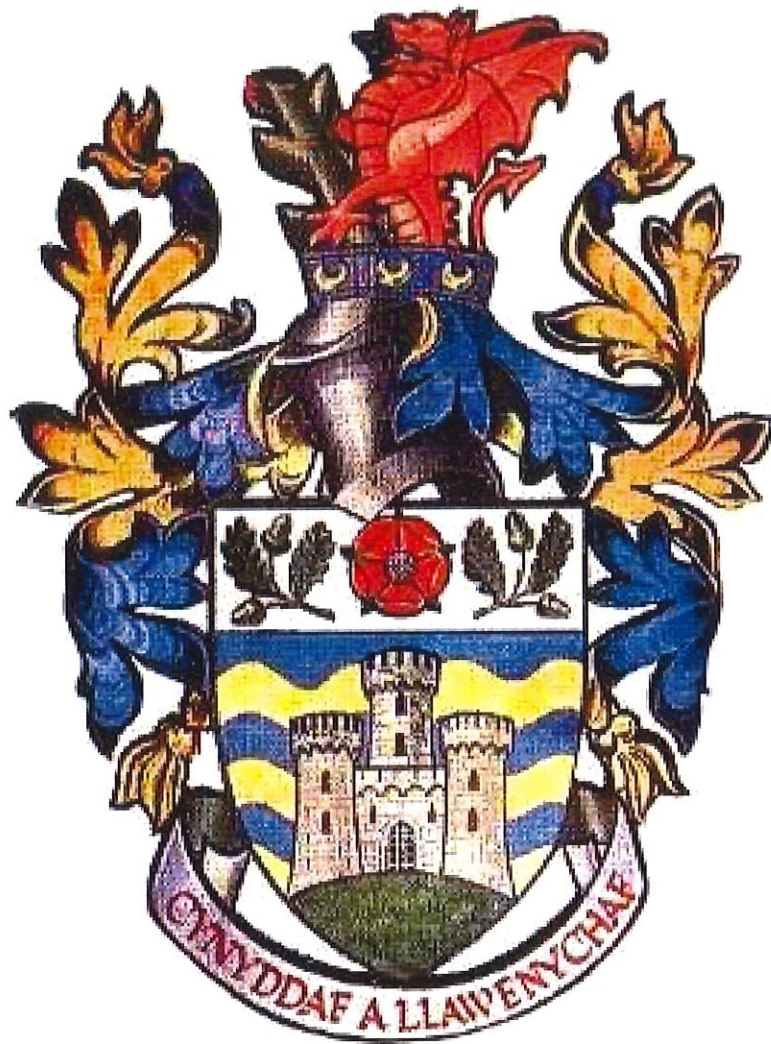
Nant Hall Rd

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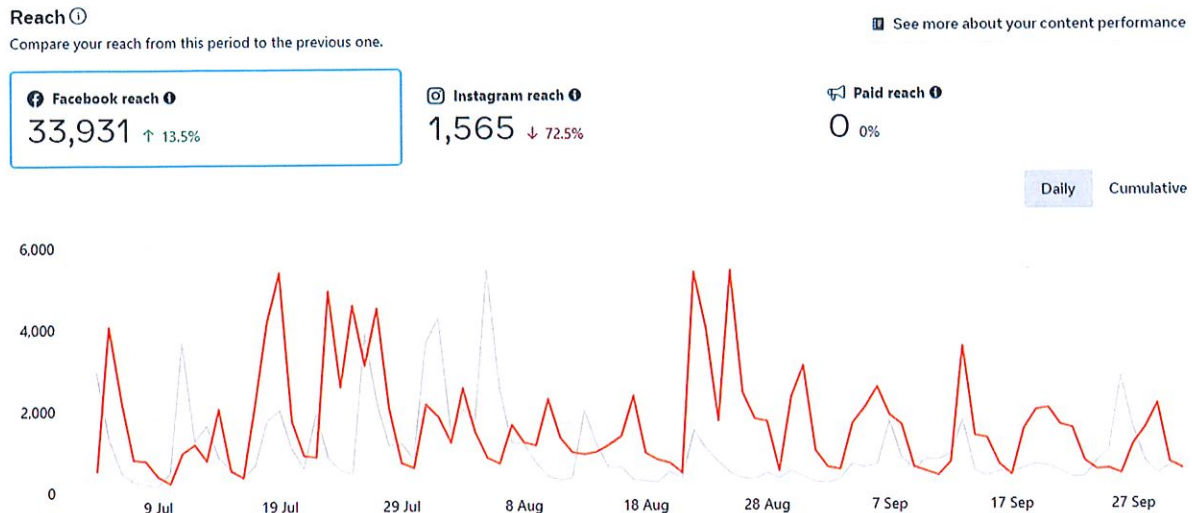

The graph indicates an increase in the current 90 days. This could be due to the different types of media being posted, for example videos and 'clicks' to the website.

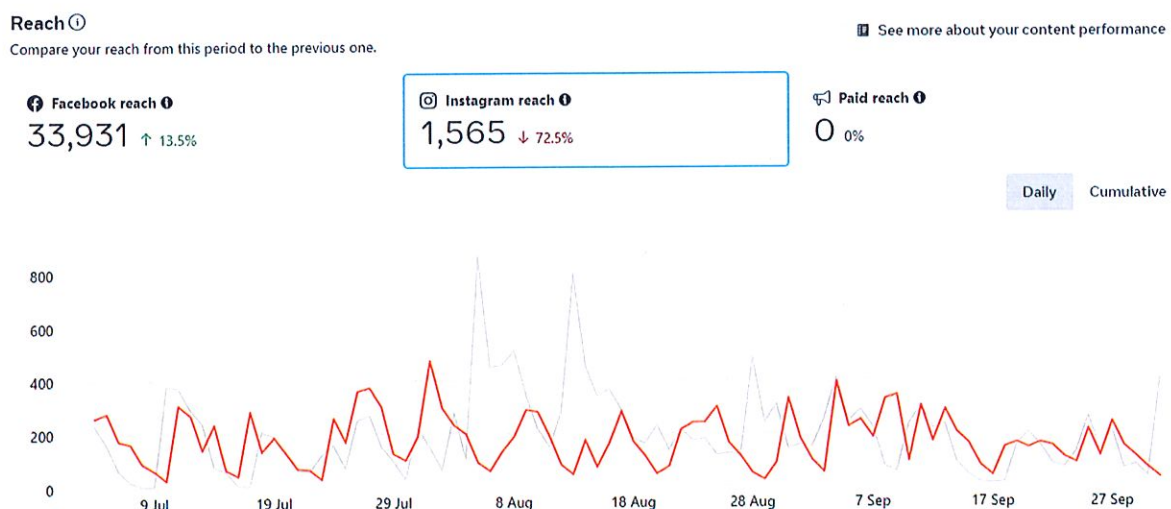


PTC INSTAGRAM REACH:

Background

The purpose of the above named organisation is to play a key role in the management of the CCTV partnership between the towns of Prestatyn, Rhuddlan and Rhyl. North Wales Police, Denbighshire County Council also have a role in the Partnership and the town of Denbigh will soon be an additional town entering the Partnership from 1st April 2024

Notes from Meeting held on 26.7.23

Crime

It was reported at the meeting that there has been a large increase in Theft and Handling crimes. North Wales Police have been working with Tesco to try and influence their shop layout which is felt contributes to the ease by which perpetrators can carryout shop lifting. These crimes have certainly hit national press and is described as an epidemic. Specific figures on incidents were requested by the next meeting

Overall, crime has declined across Denbighshire Coastal district in the last 12 months, reduction in Rhyl by 10% and in Prestatyn by 5%. However retail theft has not reduced and it is felt that punishment is not enough of a deterrent. An example of which was cited that a perpetrator in Prestatyn Tesco was in magistrates court for a shoplifting offence and was imprisoned for 1 week. Within 24 hours he had committed the same crime again. Business burglary is also remaining at a constant and not reducing

Prestatyn's night time economy is growing and NWP operations have increased over the summer to deal with this

Budget and Contracts

All income from partners have been paid and a healthy pot from Safer Streets initiative. No concerns re budget at the moment, however Safer Streets 5 application is open and this will require match funding. A request to search for grant funding was made. Town Clerks to investigate

New contracts are likely to cost more. The cost of the maintenance budget will be known soon. The monitoring contract was due to end in August 2023, but will be extended by 12 months

All cameras in Prestatyn which are supported by PTC funds are in working order apart from Banastre Avenue. A bid to the Shared Prosperity Fund has been made to replace all 40 cameras which are older than 4 years. If successful drawdown can commence April 2024 with a completion date October 2024.

Development of tender documents for new contracts are underway. Rhyl BID is balloting their members in November to ascertain if they would like to join the Partnership. If the response is positive this will impact greatly on the tender's content

A new server is required as the current one will not be covered by maintenance contract after 2024. The estimated cost of this is circa £100k
