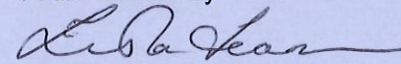

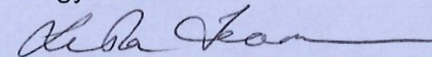

Prestatyn TC – CCTV Briefing Note

September 2022

Next Denbighshire CCTV Partnership Meeting is 26 September.

Given this is a new Board following elections there will be the appointment of a new Chair and a review / reminder of meeting arrangements.

Partnership Board budget update will be in place for the Board meeting

Camera Update – see attached. Points to note:

- Locations in green are high priority; yellow is medium priority, red are low priority
- Camera 810 is an additional camera installed after agreement of priorities
- Operator noted faulty cameras are indicated by brown highlight with two other cameras (762 and 771) noted by users. Camera status will be subject to a review before Board meeting and further update given at that meeting.
- All high priority cameras have been replaced. Only 3 cameras are aged.
- The network is further supported by an additional 12 cameras in Prestatyn that cover car parks and the bus station.

Replacements were as a result of grant funding supplemented by Partnership contributions

Contracts for monitoring and maintenance expire within the next 12 months. Partnership Board will agree ways forward.
