Event

The Mayor Achievement Awards were first advertised in the beginning of September 2025. For people to engage and nominate people within their circles for one of the three awards: Special Recognition which 5 people were awarded, Environmental no one was nominated for this award, and Community Enterprise which 5 people were awarded. Also, Bob Murray was awarded the Champion Volunteer. People were coming in the Prestatyn Town Council office frequently to ask for a nomination form. However, after being prompted on emails people were submitting their forms in. However, there were many people phoning in asking for the parameters for each award. A suggestion would be to recreate the nomination forms with clear definitions for each award.

Everyone was on time for the event; there were 55 people that attended the meeting. There were enough seats for the nominees and the guests that were invited. However, there should be more room for accessibility reasons. Such as people with wheelchairs, and people with walking apparatus. Furthermore, the temperature was warmer than usual.

The refreshments were served by Kieyara and Madam Mayor and was continually topped up throughout the evening. However, with taking pictures and videos for social media, topping up the refreshments in conjunction with being a media presence became challenging. For the next Mayor's Achievement Awards, there should be volunteers involved.

Decorations were limited and seasonal for the Mayor's Achievement Awards, in future decoration for the room and for photo opportunities that display 'Prestatyn Town Council: Mayor's Achievement Awards (year of ceremony)' should be considered for the budget.

Each nominee was presented with a certificate that were created by Kieyara, which was further personalised by Madam Mayor. Moreover, trophies were presented to the winners. However, during the night there was only a few awards for the select few. This was rectified by Madam Mayor ordering more awards from the Mayoral account, furthermore these were presented a week later in the organisation's event (KIM Inspire – was present at their Winterfest at King's Hall, and Deva Church – was present at their Warm Hubs).

During December and January, 337 people attended our Warm Hubs session in our 3 sites which are Deva Church on Tuesdays, Jubilee Community Centre on Wednesdays, and Meliden Community Centre on Fridays. Since then, 15 sessions were attended by organisations that have supported our community. Alzheimer's Society visited in January and have commented that they enjoyed their visit and cannot wait to visit our other locations. Furthermore, Warm Wales have commented that they have been in contact with 17 individuals from the sessions

they attended. They further commented that engagement was significantly higher than the past Warm Hubs.

The Warm Hubs initiative have since been extended to March. The projected costs for February and March 2026 have been calculated to be £2,335.

Event

Dydd Santes Dwynwen Hapus was planned during December 2025. The posters were then posted on 5 January 2026 and were posted on social media thereafter.

This was a well-attended event with over 55 people attending. Everyone was engaged with the storyteller. We have used Professor Llusern's services in the past from 2025's St David's Day. Professor Llusern performed Welsh songs, poems and stories which was then translated in English.

The tables were set up by the Nant Hall Church caretaker. Overall, there was 9 tables, from there Kieyara set up the space with Welsh decorations, daffodils, roses and print outs of simple Welsh conversations that visitors could practise with. There was engagement with the print outs, and some took them home. The Welsh Government has released a policy and strategy that highlights that they want to reach one million [Welsh speakers by 2050](#). Therefore, a suggestion would be to introduce Welsh in handouts, and to incorporate Welsh in future events in engaging way that the people can remember them for their day to day lives.

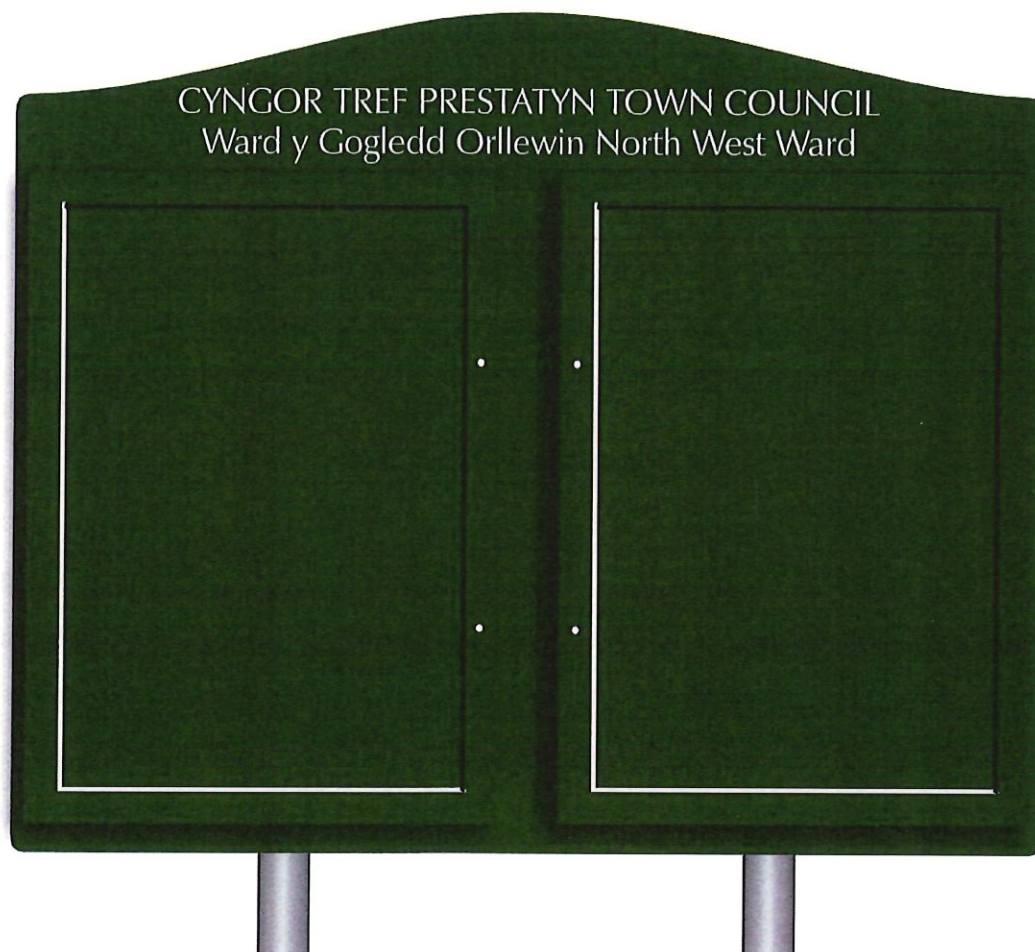

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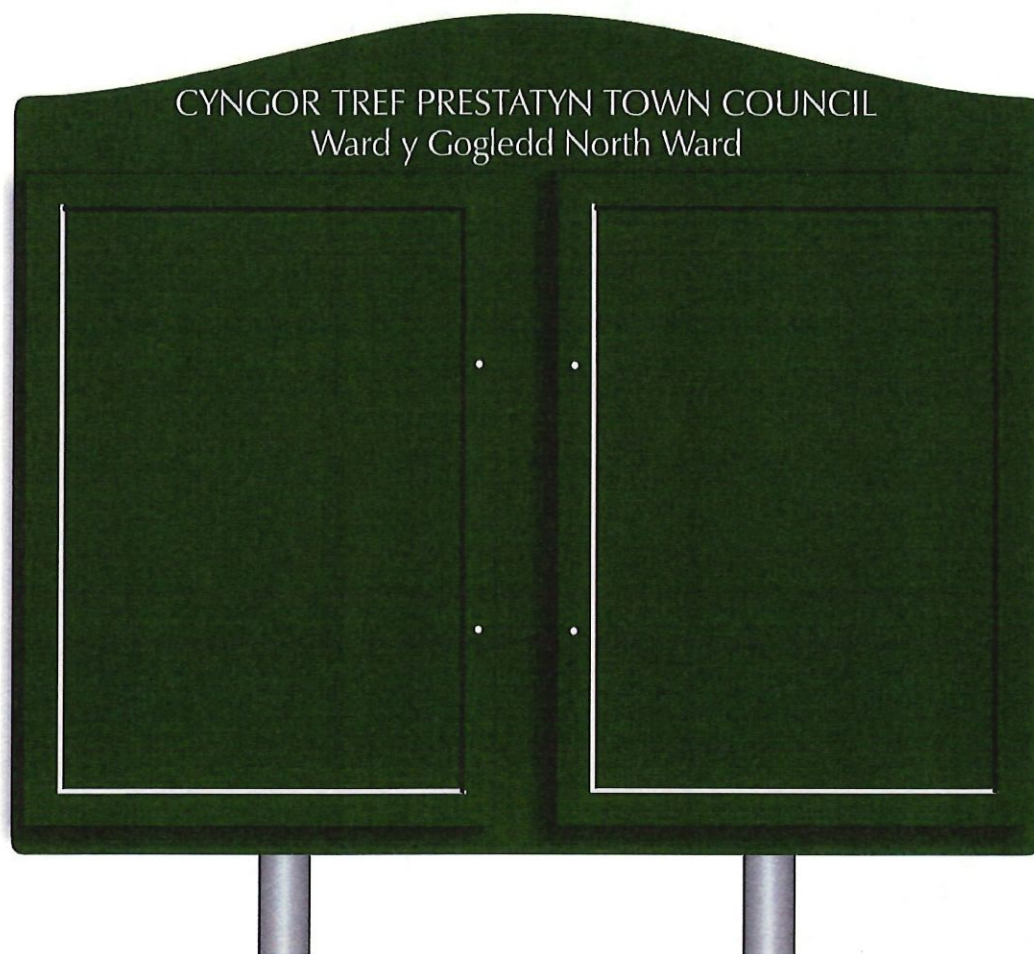

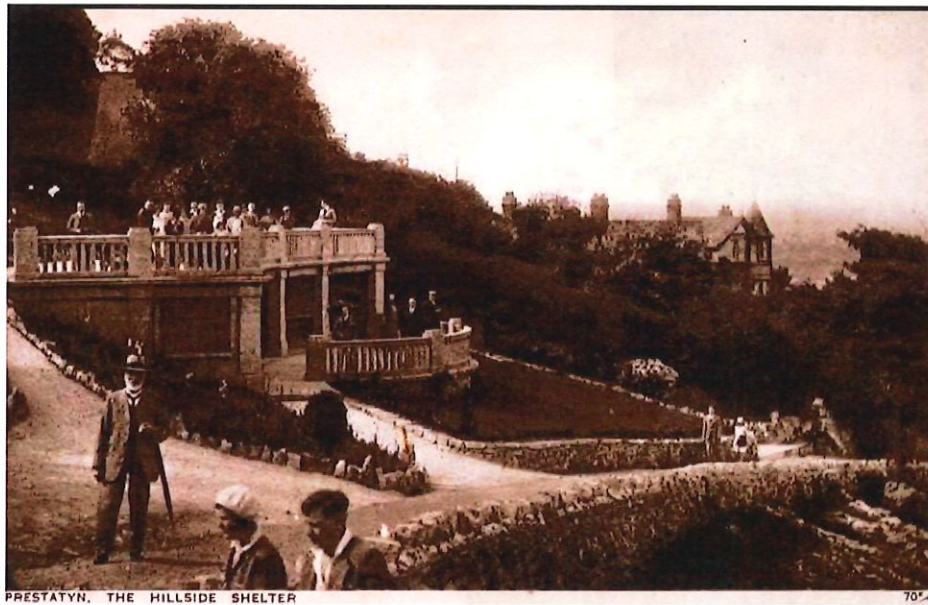

Hillside Gardens were built in the 1920's, transforming a former quarry into a place of beauty and leisure.

The huge, creamy coloured building at the site is quite simply a 'viewing platform'. It was built and opened in 1929, funded by a local benefactor. It was located here as it was the highest point in Prestatyn which could be reached by 'motorcar', to enjoy the glorious views of the sea and the new resort town of Prestatyn, Denbighshire, North Wales.

The building is historically important, and even listed, as it is one of the earliest known structures to be built out of concrete.



Two lonely figures stare out to sea, one representing the past, one representing the now. Surrounded by landscaped gardens cut into the rocky hillside, hardy flowers and fresh sea air, they stand atop something even more remarkable.

The figures mentioned above were carved by award-winning local chainsaw artist Simon O'Rourke. The hiker, located at the east of the structure, represents the thousands of feet which cross this way today walking the Offa's Dyke Path National Trail and enjoying the North Wales countryside. The lady to the west represents the era the structure at Hillside Gardens was built and the gardens created.

Two sculptures one of a male and the other a female were installed in 2017 at the Hillside Gardens shelter. Created by Rossett-based chainsaw artist Simon O'Rourke, they represent a modern-day walker and one from the 1920s.

The 1920s female sculpture marks the era the shelter was built, while the modern-day rambler is intended to represent the Offa's Dyke National Trail.

Mr O'Rourke had spent "under three days" on each sculpture, installed them himself, and at the time said the venture had been "very rewarding".



The figures were installed with funding from Denbighshire County Council's Town and Area Plan (TAP) funding, Natural Resources Wales, Prestatyn Town Council and the Burbo Bank offshore wind farm – with help from the local Offa's Dyke Support group.



August 2024, the female sculpture had been vandalised with the sculpture knocked off its platform and its arms "chopped off". The male sculpture was left unharmed, however has since been vandalised.



Simon O'Rourke can complete a full refurb and repair on the lady which would include a refresh of the hiker too, so they both look fresh. The arms will be made in a much more compact way for strength, and the strength of the base attachment can be increased with a thick steel plate which will also help with stability and make less susceptible to damage.

He has also quoted to repair the man, which would make a total of £5k for repairs.
