Report from Debbie Hughes – health and community support officer (16hrs)

Cycling

Prestatyn Social Riders - meet twice weekly Monday and Wednesday from the Calvary church.

This ride is advertised on the Go Sky Ride website and follows the rules and guidelines of the British cycling social ride (poster attached). This ride is also advertised on the exercise referral scheme as an exit route. This group of approximately 12 riders is now well established with excellent support from cyclist Peter Thomas. Bikes and helmets are regularly used from the container. I continue to support the group on a monthly basis depending on my work schedule.

Bike week 2014 celebration Ride- June 30th The ride from Caernarfon to Bryn Cir was attended by 12 cyclists travelling with the trailer from the Calvary church to Caernarfon. One of the riders attending has only recently started back cycling after 30 years! She has been taking part in my cycle confidence sessions previously.

Cycle Confidence sessions – From the Calvary Church 7 people have attended these sessions since March 14, three from the exercise referral scheme. Bikes and helmets used regularly.

Schools Cycling Programme - 6 week course at Marsh Tracks 5th June – 10th July. Three Schools attending Ysgol Melyd, Ysgol y Llys, Ysgol Penmorfa (26 children from years 5 and 3 teachers). The course has been headed by an experienced coach Alan Overson with the children learning many skills and gaining confidence in all 3 disciplines of riding including racing circuit, BMX and mountain bikes. The comments from the children and teachers have all been positive. The children were awarded certificates on their last session.

Cycle coaching for schools – Ann Williams welsh development coach advertising for teachers/assistants and parents to take up Level 1 coaching (1 day course). This will be funded by welsh cycling. Leaflets given to the 3 schools taking part in above programme with the aim of having names forwarded for the course by end September.

Cycling skills HLAP – 4 sessions at Marsh tracks 23rd July/5th August 2 girls only and 2 mixed sessions

Walking

YNWA beginners walk- Every Monday 2pm from PTC on programme. Continued support from DH and advertised and attended by NERS clients.

Walking Festival – Friday 16th -18th May. St Melyd Parish Trail walk led by DH SE and Julie Salmon. 35 people attended the walk to Melyd church enjoying welsh refreshments and singing from 20 members of the Vale singers choir! Reverend Harvey and the church wardens gave us a warm welcome including a talk on the church's history.

Coed y Morfa Allotment club

14 children registered this year with excellent and invaluable support from Mairwena Grant. The club started back on the 5th March preparing and planting for the year. Slugs have been a menace this year!

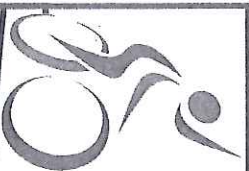

Growing for Gold – 8th April planting golden pollinator seeds to support the RHS growing for gold campaign 50th year anniversary

Bug house's – 24th June session run by Adrian Hibbert DCC making hotels/houses for bee's and bugs

Vertical hydroponic growing – 1st July. Eco session delivered by Stuart Owen using recycled bottles. The children have a lovely display on the fence at the allotments. Many thanks to Stuart for giving this very interesting free workshop

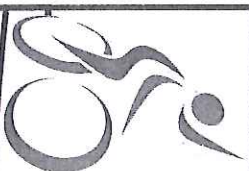
In addition to teachers, Cycling for Schools is open to all adults (aged 18 and over), who work or volunteer within the schools sector.
