(a) Purpose & Benefit to Prestatyn:

Design and installation of 6 giant individual sculptures depicting the motion of a whale tail slapping the water. These giant structures will not only be a sight to behold, but act as recycling bins to encourage tourists and locals to clear up plastic pollutants and rubbish off our beaches. We have engaged a fantastic artist & environmentalist, Jacha, (responsible for Edith the Rhino in Betws-Y-Coed) who will design and fabricate the sculptures free of charge. We're engaging with the local community, raising awareness of the effects that plastic waste has on our coastline and the wider marine environment.

As part of the fundraising efforts for the project, a fun calendar has been created (inspired by the well know Calenda girls). Two local photographers volunteered their time and knowledge to organise and photograph people from local businesses and community groups. The calendar is to be sold locally.

Since March 2020, we have maintained our service remotely (by telephone, email and videolink), increasing our telephone lines and strengthening our network with the third sector and voluntary agencies, to ensure we are able to support those digitally excluded and the most vulnerable. We are continuing to support clients in Prestatyn.
