

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER

Denbighshire County Council

Nant Hall Road and Ty Nant access road, Prestatyn

Notice of Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic Order

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 - Section 14(1)

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 6th December 2023 to make an Order prohibiting vehicles using the lengths of road stated in the Schedule.

The closure is to facilitate electrical works by O'Connor Utilities on behalf of Scottish Power. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the closure.

The signposted alternative route is stated in the Schedule

The Order is effective from 8th January 2024 for eighteen-months or earlier completion of the works whichever is soonest. The works are expected to last approximately until 19th January 2024.

Schedule

Lengths of road at Prestatyn in the County of Denbigh

i) Nant Hall Road; extending westward from its junction with Ty Nant access road to its junction with Church Lane.

ii) Ty Nant Access road; extending westward from a point 20 metres west of its junction with High Street for a distance of approximately 20m

Recommended alternative routes:

i) via High Street and Gronant Road

ii) via Gronant Road, Meliden Road, Ffordd Pendyffryn, Penisardre Road and High Street
